The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mike Noel.

The Directors (and others) recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Upon the motion of Mike McCabe, seconded by Randy Tyler, the minutes of the July 18, 2019 regular meeting were unanimously approved.

Upon the motion of Greg McAdams, seconded by Jim Kittle, the claims and vouchers were unanimously approved with the addition of the Reedy Financial Group invoice.

New Business

Unfinished Business

Anticipate USACE final approval on SCADA design within the week. Once approved, the project will be sent out for bid.

Discharge pipe repair is complete. Awaiting invoice.

Pump Station #5 building repair is complete.

Section 408 Request and plans for Flaherty & Collins housing development were sent to USACE for their review. Upon the motion of Al Abdon, seconded by Mike McCabe, Resolution 2019-11 was approved.

Cleaning and power washing at the sports complex is complete.

The survey on the Bruce Lagory land request is complete. Next step is to have the property appraised.

Hollywood Casino sports better is opening the first week of September and will hold a grand opening event on 9/8. They have requested to put up a large tent on LCD property near the casino. Upon the motion of Greg McAdams,
